All About the Mishkan: Lapbook

Grade Level: Middle School, High School

Description:

An entire unit about the Mishkan grouped into small units of information and presented in one beautiful folder. Topics include the nedavos, the kailim, and the setup of the mishkan. Striking full-color illustrations are included and blanks are provided for students to fill in the appropriate information. The folder can be used instead of conventional worksheets or as an illustrative addition. Please note: There is an additional component that is still in progress. When it is created, it will be added to the files.



How to Download:

- Download the print-ready PDF for the pieces used in the folder. (includes lesson plan/instructions)
- OPTIONAL: Download the editable Publisher files. (does not include lesson plan/instructions)

Goals/Objectives:

Students will record information about the mishkan and combine the components into a beautiful folder.

Materials Needed:

- Color File Folder
- Return Address Labels (Avery 5967)
- Velcro
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Stapler
- Sample of the foldable organizer made by teacher before class

Instructions:

- 1. Open the file folder. Fold both sides inwards to meet in the middle (creating a two "door" folder). Crease the folds.
- 2. Print the foldable pieces on cardstock.
- 3. Cut out the double heart leaving the gap in the middle. Fold it in half. Cut out the cover and paste on top.

4. The three "klei hamishkan" tables will be layered one on top of the other.

Table 1: Cut out the blank table. Glue it down in the center of the folder. Table 2: Cut out the word table. Cut along the lines (indicated with a scissor) to create fringes. Make sure that there is a horizontal strip in the middle left uncut. Put glue the top edge, bottom edge, and the center strip. Paste it on top of the first page. Be sure that the fringes are not glued down.


Table 3: Cut out the picture table. Cut along the lines (indicated with a scissor) to create six flaps. Put glue on the top edge, bottom edge, and the center strip. Paste it on top of the other two pages to create a third layer.



5. Cut out the square of pictures and paste it on the top of the right folder flap. Cut out the blue strips. Paste each strip on top of the corresponding row of pictures. Cut on the black lines between the names to create separate square flaps.



6. Cut out the box with the paroches circles. Paste it in the middle of the right folder flap.

- 7. Cut out the two large boxes (leaving the line in the middle). One box is completely blank and the other has a picture of the yirios. Fold each along the middle line. Place the smaller folded box inside the larger yerios box. Staple the papers together on the fold. You have just created a layered booklet with the yirios picture as the cover.
- 8. Print the labels. The labels should be placed on the bottom edges of the layered booklet in the following order. Mechasa on the shortest layer. Ohel on the middle layer. Mishkan on the bottom layer. Glue the booklet on the bottom of the right folder flap.



9. Cut out the tavnis hamishkan box and the numbered box. Place the numbered box inside the yerios box. Fold down the middle and staple. Glue the blank the pages together. Paste the booklet in the top of the left folder flap.





10. Cut out the picture of the mishkan and paste it onto the back of the folder.



11. Have students add the information learned into the appropriate sections. Answers are not provided. Under each flap of the nedavos, the students should write what it purpose was in the mishkan. Have the students write a lesson that they learned in the flap of the heart.







Diagram of how the finished cube should look.






