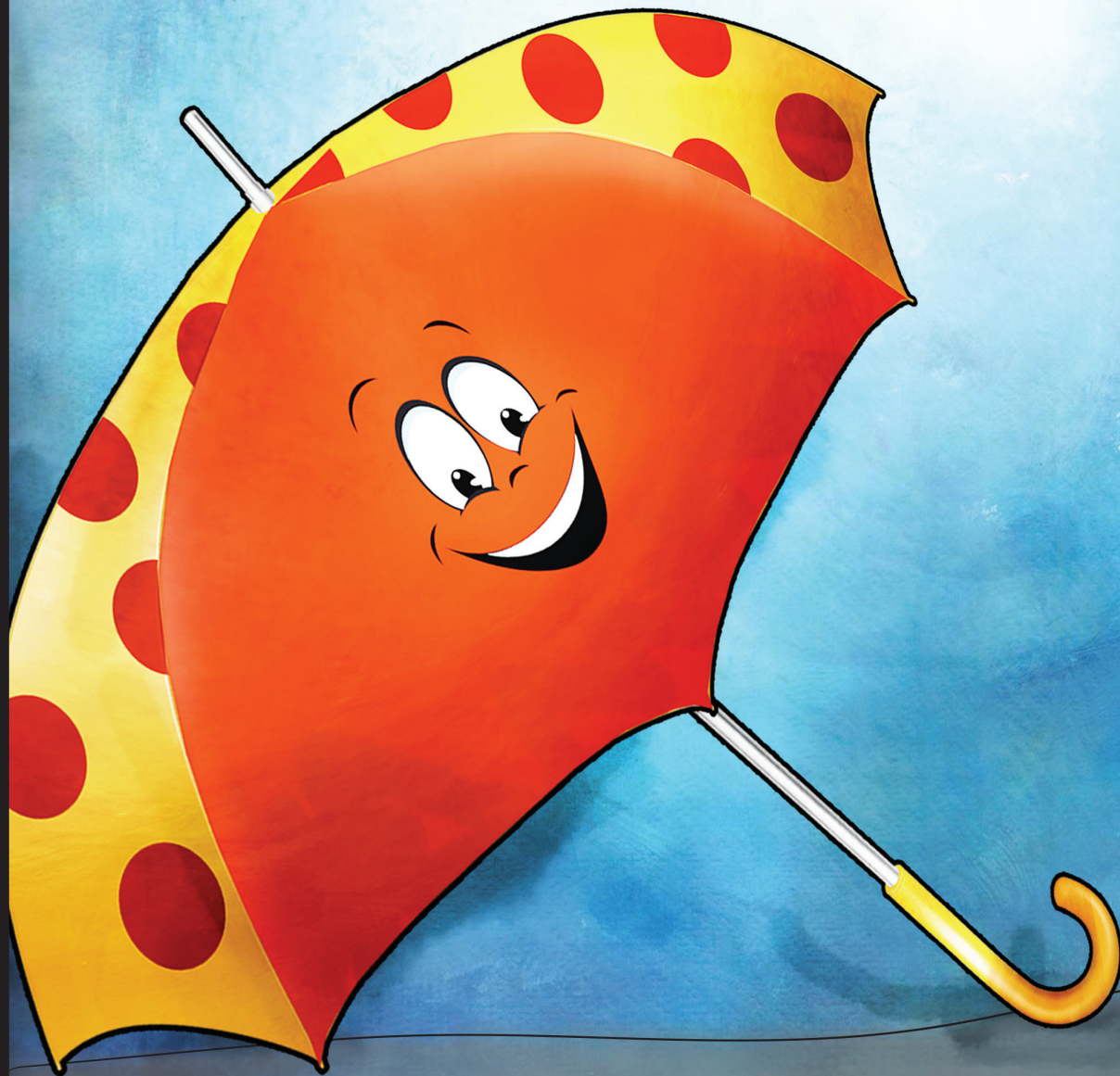
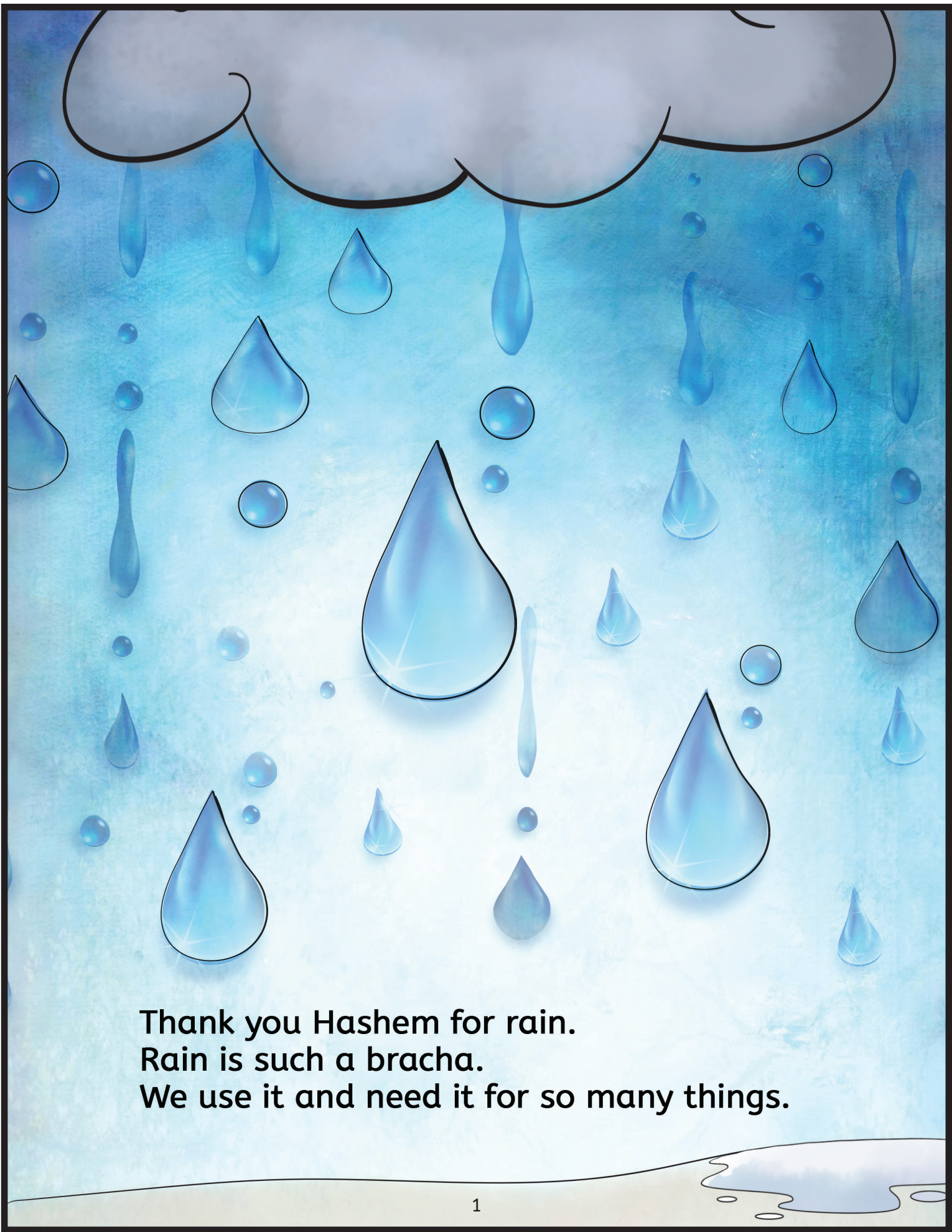


# The Bracha of Rain

Nothing better can be found.



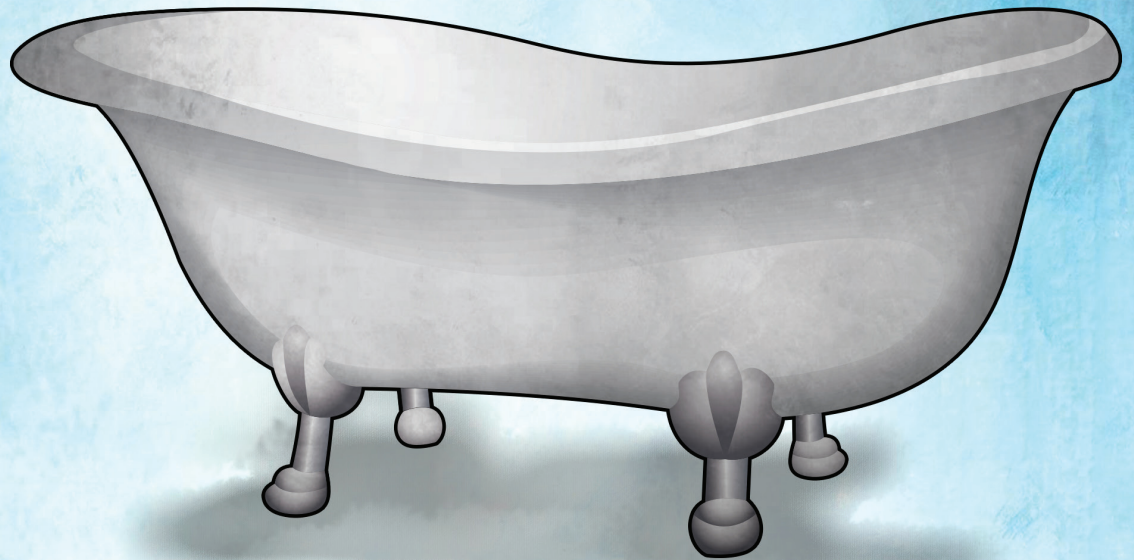
For Mitzvos we need water too.

With soap and water it can be fun.





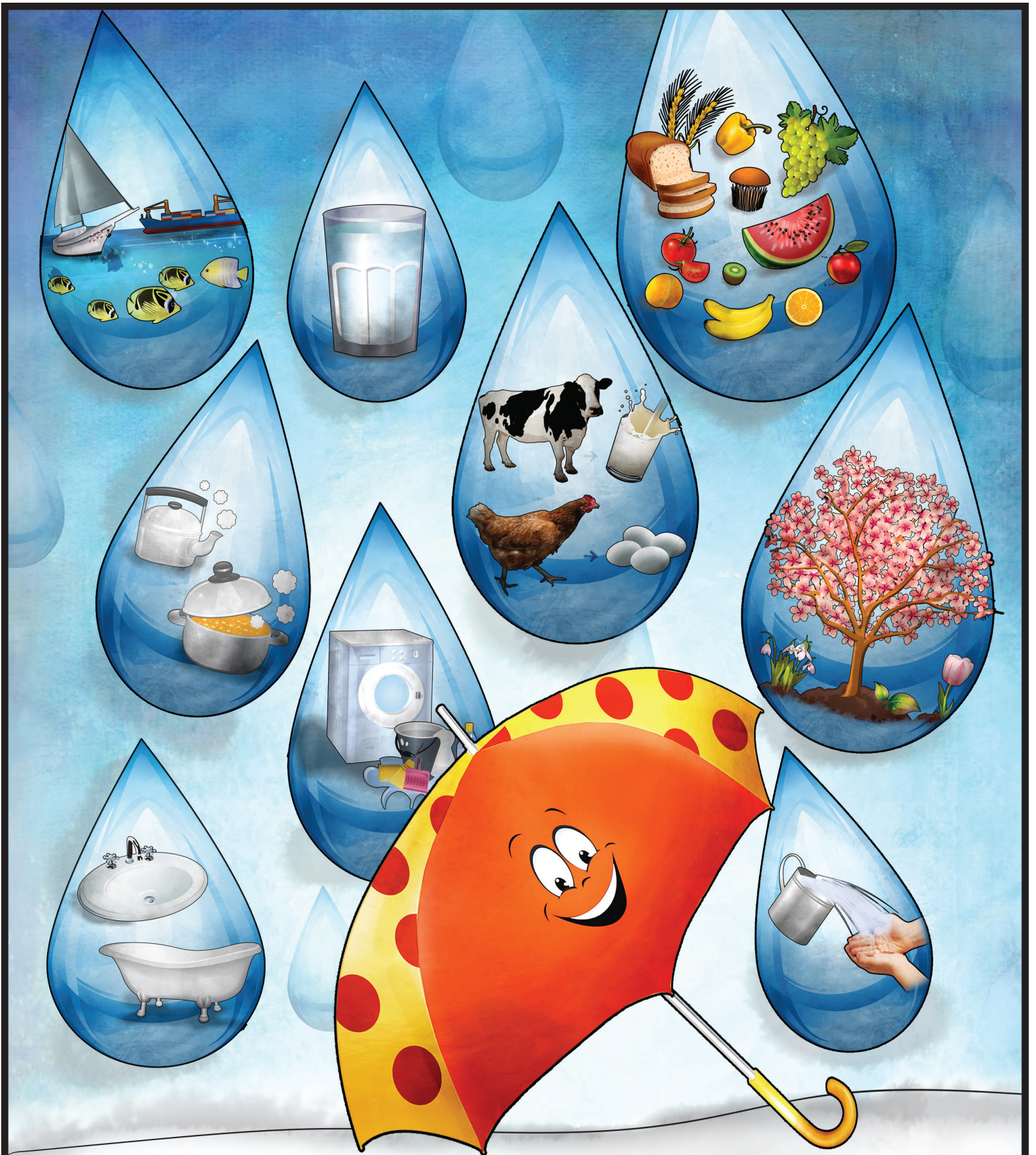
Rain is needed so colorful flowers can be seen,
