Ma Nishtana Wheel

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Grade Level: Early Childhood

Description:

A colorful wheel for students to display each of the ma nishtana as they are recited! Prereading students rely on the clear photographs to guide them. There is some text for each of the questions, but does not include the whole ma nishtana. In addition, large numbers help the children say the ma nishtana in the correct sequence. This easy to create wheel is a perfect tool for practicing the ma nishtana in school and for sending home with the students.

Goals/Objectives:

Students will recite the ma nishtana using the wheel as a guide.

Materials Needed:

- Color Printer
- Paper Fastener

Instructions:

- 1. Print a circle and the cover. Cut a pie shaped wedge in the cover.
- 2. Poke a hole in the middle of both circles. Weave a paper fastener through the holes.
- 3. Have the children practice saying the ma nishtana using the circle as a guide. The students turn the cover to display the question they are asking.
