The Torah Umesorah Lakewood Teacher Center is happy to provide you with a brand new, fresh and exciting Megillah for your students. It is highly visual for your students, and they will enjoy the hands on approach to learning the Purim story and completing this Megillah. Learning about Purim will prove to be a very enriching and stimulating learning experience. The mission is for the students to gain an understanding of the events in the Purim story and will be familiar with the text of the Megillah. Key important phrases from the Megillah have been chosen for your students to master in this program.

Student Megillah

This Megillah can be used on two different learning levels. LEVEL I is geared to Grades I-2. LEVEL 2 is geared to Grades 3-4. The Megillah pages are printed exactly the same, yet the information that the students are writing in level 2 is lengthier and more detailed. The teacher will determine which level is appropriate for her students.

Inside Pages

On each page, the students will write a summarizing sentence reflecting the event portrayed in the picture. They can write it in Hebrew, and then in English in their own words.

They will also fill in the missing words of the Megillah phrase (located on the fold of the page), using the proper (enclosed) labels. This phrase is an exact reflection of what is portrayed in the picture.

Assessment Activity

There is an additional hands on activity for your students to engage in as an assessment of how well they have mastered the phrases from the Megillah. Your students will get a stack of Megillah phrases. They will have to choose the Megillah character that is connected to each phrase and place the character in the "MI ANI" circle.


Teacher's Edition






It is our hope that the use of this Megillah in your classroom will provide the students with a solid understanding and a rich fluency of Megillas Esther.








Esther became the new queen of Achashveirosh.




Mordechai refused to bow down to Haman.


Haman wore a 600 on his robe and Mordechai knew that a

Jew cannot bow down to a person wearing a 600.


This made Haman very angry and caused him to plan on killing Mordechai as well as Mordechai's entire nation.


