

Order of Maggid Game

Grade Level:

Middle Elementary (4-5)

Educational Goals/Objectives:

Students will sequence the parts of maggid.

Description:

Dramatic illustrations persuade students to practice sequencing the parts of Maggid. The game can be played individually, in partners, or as a classroom activity.



Materials Needed:

- Printouts of Maggid cards and base
- Velcro dots
- Small dot stickers (Numbered 1-15)

Material Preparation:

1. Print, laminate and cut the Maggid cards and base of game.
2. Place a number sticker on the back of each card according to its place in the Haggadah.
3. Place a Velcro dot in each square of the base and on the back of each card.
4. Place the cards in a bag and attach the bag to the base.

Detailed Instructions – Classroom Use:

1. When teaching, place the base on the blackboard.
2. Hold each card up and place in the correct order.
3. For review, have students play the game on their own, picking cards out of the bag and placing them in order on the base.
4. Students can check if they are correct by using the stickers on the back of the cards.

Variation(s):

- Print each card in full page size. Have students write notes for each part of Maggid on the back of the coordinating page. Let them color and decorate the pictures for a beautiful and easy Haggadah.
- Use full-page printouts of the cards as section covers in the Haggadah.
- Print out a set of cards for each student. Hole punch the cards and place on a keyring. During the Seder, students can follow the Haggadah using the cards. You can also teach a דבר תורה for each part and print it on the back of the coordinating card.
