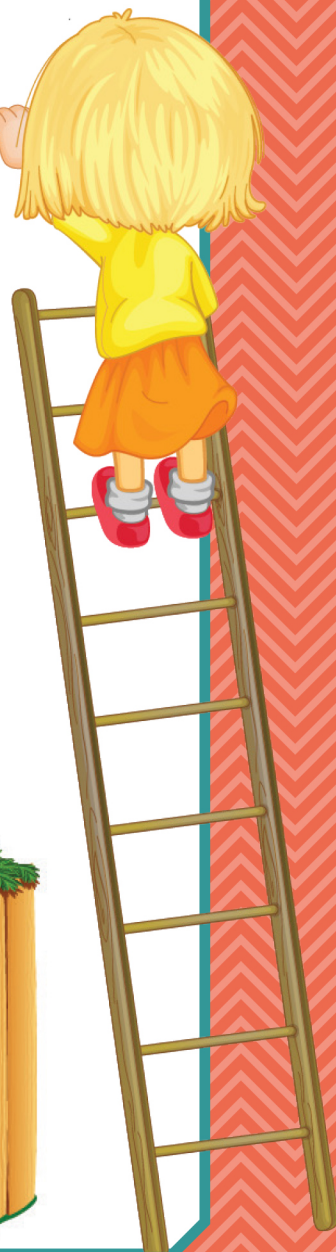




IS IT

So Chesky and Chaya helped their Mommy cook and set the table. They took a nap and then got dressed for Yom Tov.

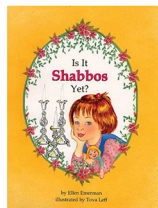


“Is it Sukkos yet?”
