Welcome to Chodesh Adar! It is time to embark on teaching Megillas Esther to your students! This "Purim Shpiel Megillah" will prove to be a most educational and exciting experience for your students. They will love every minute of their learning!

Rather than your students having fill-ins as a review of the Megillah, this Megillah offers an engaging fun review activity of the important details in each Perek. Your students will become very familiar with the key phrases of the Megillah through these review activities.

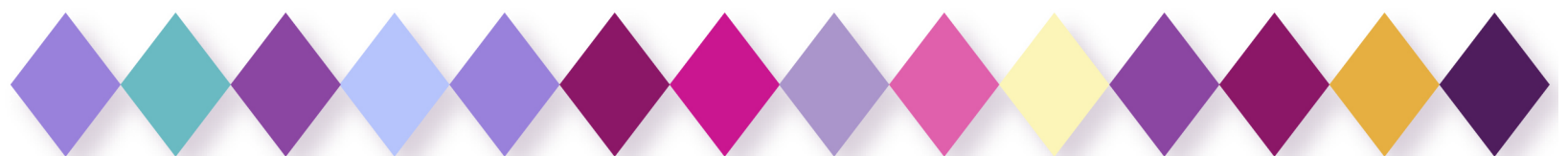
The activities used throughout the Megillah are: crossword puzzles, word finds, and unscrambling the words that are the answers. The questions that follow each Perek are written in basic Lashon Kodesh. All of the answers can easily be found in the Pasuk that is clearly indicated next to the question. The answer to each question is then put in the puzzle, found in a word find, or unscrambled from the choices at the bottom of the page. You can refer to the Teacher's Answer Key for the proper answers.

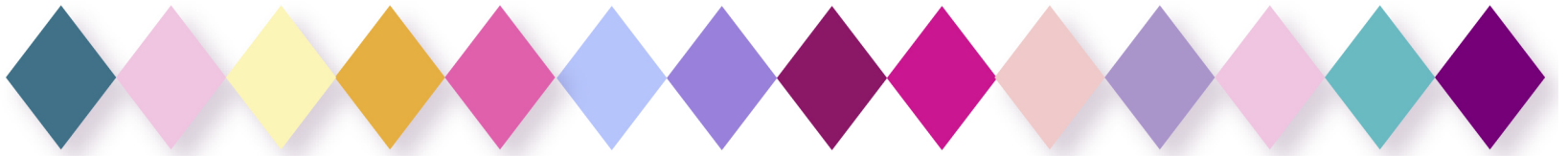
Please read the instructions below so that you will have clarity of how to assemble this Megillah and how to maximize its' use.

FRONT AND BACK COVER:

The cover of this Megillah is a project of its own! It is delightful but simple to use:

1. Print the front cover on an 8.5x11 label. (online label)
2. Print the first page of numbers on hard 8.5x11 paper, black and white.
3. The students cut out each colorful square and stick it in the appropriate numbered box. The end result will be a sensational Megillas Esther cover!
4. The back cover should be printed on hard 8.5x11, color.



**MEGILLAH PAGES:**

The entire Megillah should be printed on soft 8.5x11 paper. It is up to you if you want to print the Megillah pages in color or in black and white.

Every Perek ends with a nice coloring picture reflecting the events of that Perek.

ICONS:

At the top of each activity page is an icon that indicates what type of activity that Perek has. There is a puzzle icon, a magnifying glass icon for the word search, and multi-direction arrows for the unscrambling activity.

BONUS DRAWING ACTIVITY:

As an added extra, there is an enjoyable drawing activity at the end of the Megillah. Your students will learn how to draw a professional clown and queen!

Wow, such a shpiel! May the enthusiasm created from the use of this Megillah carry over into the most simcha-filled Purim ever!
