Optical Illusion Activity

Suggested age level: 6+

Study this optical illusion. Although the lines appear slanted, they are in fact parallel lines. Use this Optical Illusion Activity to teach your child the valuable lesson from this week's Pirkei Avos "הוי דן את כל האדם לכף זכות"

Judge every person favorable because "Things aren't always the way they appear to be!"

Materials:

Scissors

Directions:

1. Cut one sheet on the bold lines. You will now have several strips.
2. Arrange the strips in parallel lines; all black squares and all white squares will be parallel one to another. Point out to your child how obviously straight the lines are.
3. Now put the strips back in the original form. You can use your second sheet as a guide. The lines once again appear slanted.
