Mini Lesson

“What Would You Do If” cards help children explore scenarios like sharing toys, managing emotions, and resolving conflicts with peers.

Foster the middos of Achdus and Ahavas Yisroel in your classroom!

The cards are designed to facilitate discussions about behaviors, decision-making, emotions, and to build communication skills and social skills.

How to use the cards in a classroom:

Circle Time Discussion

Use a pocket chart to display a card during morning meetings, reading the scenario aloud to spark group conversation.

Role Playing Scenario

Pair children up and have them act out the "What would you do if..." scenario using puppets, mentchies, or props, encouraging them to find solutions together.

Yes/No- Thumbs Up/Thumbs Down

Answer a “What would you do if” card with a positive and/or negative scenario. Have students show a “yes/no” card or a “thumbs up/thumbs down” in response to the scenario.

One-on-One Intervention

Use the cards with individual students who need extra support with navigating social conflicts.
